Our Team

Patients at UVA are cared for by a team of physicians specializing in colon cancer screening and treatment, including gastroenterologists, surgeons and medical/ radiation oncologists.

The colorectal surgery team is led by two board-certified colon and rectal surgeons, Charles Friel, MD, and Traci Hedrick, MD, who specialize in minimally invasive surgical procedures, including robotic, laparoscopic surgery and transanal endoscopic microsurgery.



Drs. Friel and Hedrick perform on average between 150 and 200 cases for colorectal cancer each year — making them the most experienced colorectal surgeons in the area.

Enhanced Recovery After Surgery

In addition to providing top-notch cancer surgery, UVA offers a unique care experience called Enhanced Recovery After Surgery (ERAS). ERAS is a care philosophy that places patients and their families at the center of the care team, using many common-sense principles that enable patients to return to their normal lives as quickly as possible.
