Lateral Ankle Instability • Peroneal Tendonopathies • Adult Flatfoot

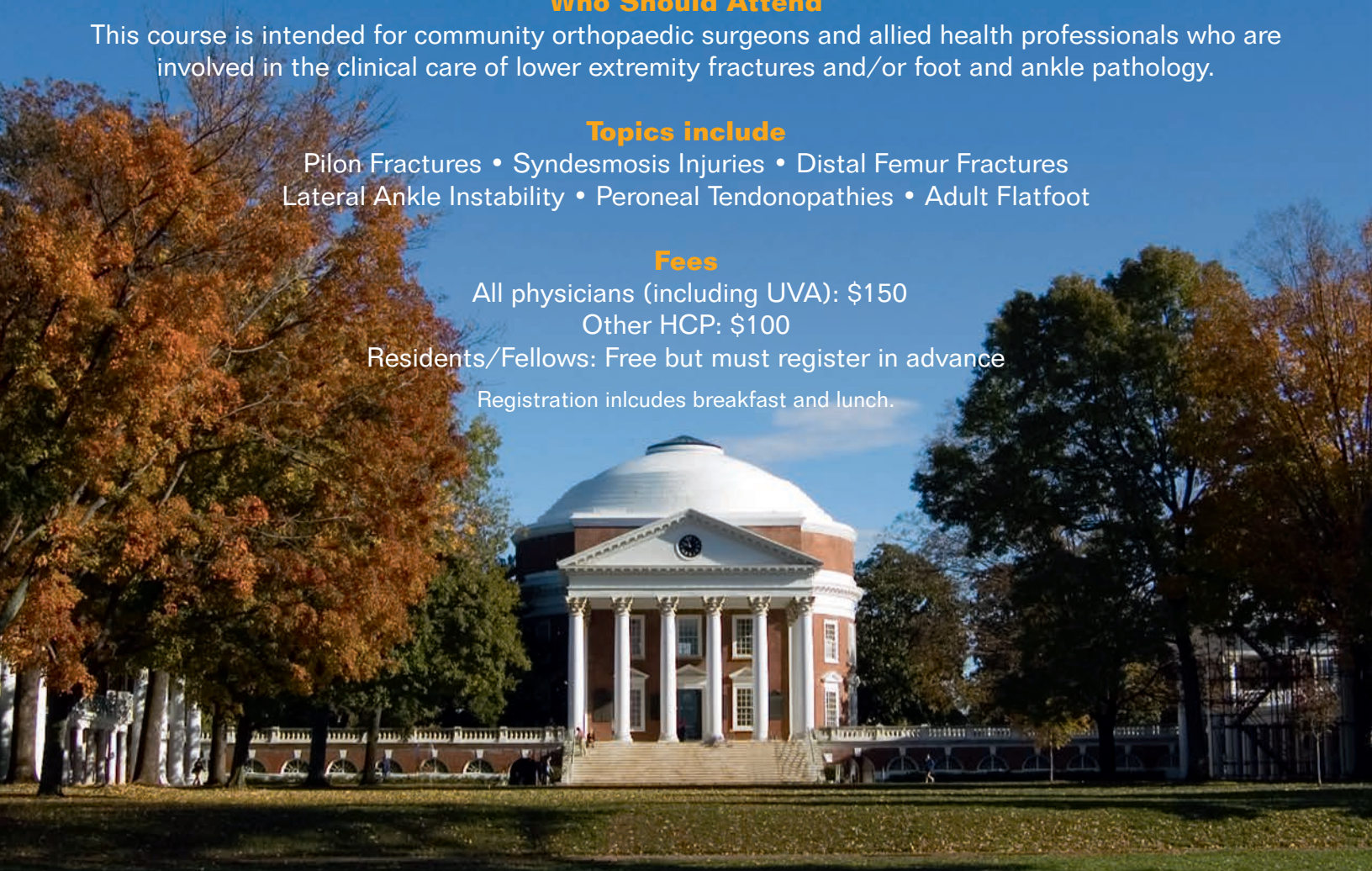
